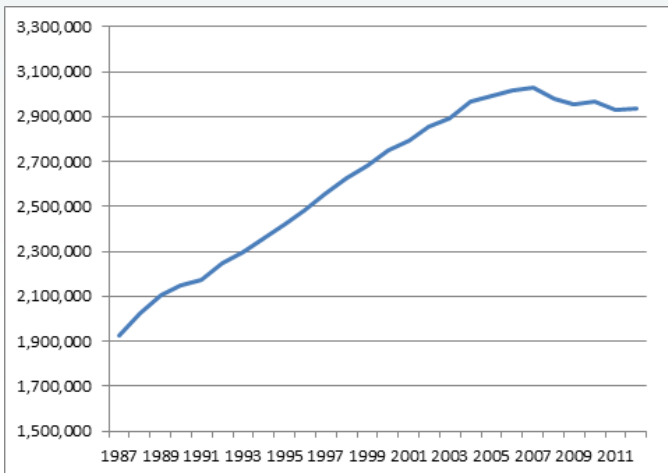


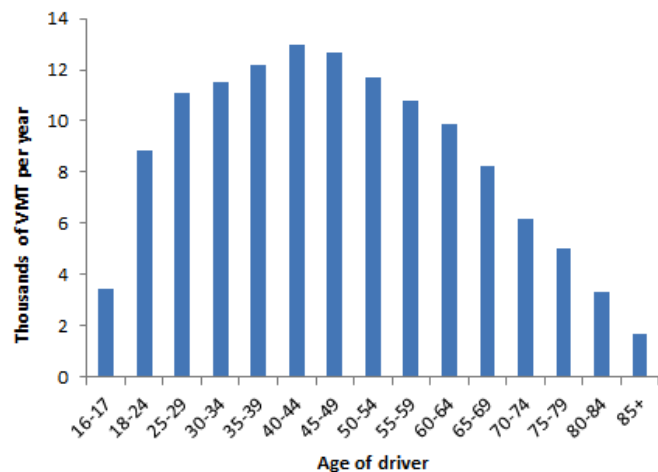

Vehicle Miles Traveled Public Works and Energy Efficiency

Metric:

Total amount of vehicle miles traveled (VMT) in New Hampshire per person:

9,660.08 miles VMT per capita in 2011

Geography: statewide

Summary:

In 2011, the estimated total amount of vehicle miles traveled (VMT) in NH was 12,720,000,000 miles. With a population of 1,316,759, this works out to a per-capita VMT of 9,660.08 miles in 2011.

The number of miles that vehicles (including light duty- vehicles [e.g., cars, small trucks], motorcycles, busses, and trucks) are driven. This provides a valuable measure by which determine if people and freight are moving around the state at increasing or decreasing rates over time.
