




Metric:

In 2011, there were 3,415,291 public transit passengers, and 95.8 miles served by transit.

Geography:

Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission region

Summary:

Ridership is measured by one-way trips on transit vehicles. Ridership is one of the key metrics concerning the effectiveness of the public transit system, as it demonstrates the people are getting real benefit from the system. The CATS (Community Alliance Transportation Services) system has especially grown over the last few years.
