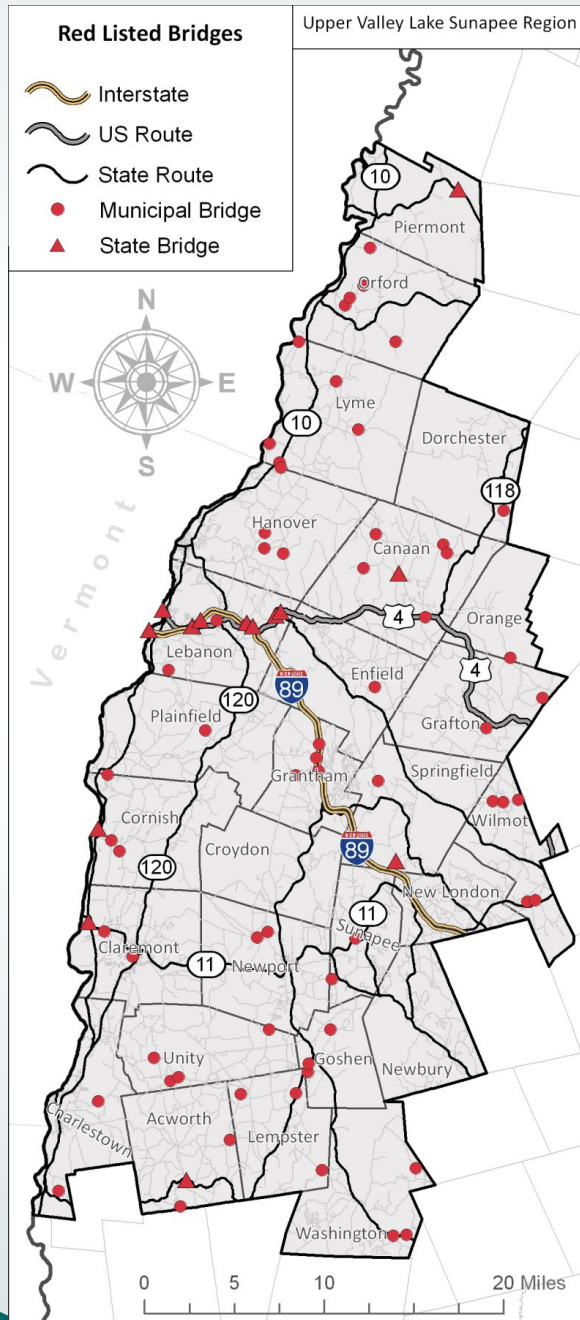




# Your Regional Plan

## Red Listed Bridges Transportation



### Metric:

This map displays 2012 New Hampshire Department of Transportation bridge condition data for state and municipally-owned bridges in the Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Region. In total, there are currently 80 Red List bridges in the UVLSRPC Region.

### Geography:

Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission region

### Summary:

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation inspects all bridges in the state.

Bridges have three structural components: Substructure, Superstructure, and Deck. The New Hampshire Department of Transportation inspects each structural element of a bridge and assigns structural sufficiency ratings ranging from “Excellent” to “Imminent Failure.”

If a bridge is found to be structurally-deficient, it is placed on the state’s “Red List” of bridges that need to be repaired or replaced.

Red listed bridges are subject to interim inspections, potential weight restrictions, and in serious cases, closure.
